Grants are offered for basic and clinical studies. Translational studies are especially welcome.</p>

MAJOR CHARACTERISTICS

Support mechanism	Projects
Eligibility:	<p>The principal investigator and any co-investigators of EFSD grant programmes must be normally employed at a non-profit institution and the study must be performed at their place of work based in Europe or an associated country.</p> <p>Unless specified otherwise, applicants to all EFSD programmes must be paid-up members of EASD. Investigators may only hold one single EFSD award at any given time. This regulation applies to principal investigators as well as co-investigators. It does not apply to collaborators.</p>
Duration	1 year or longer
Financial Support	up to Euro 100,000 for basic and/or clinical projects.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Application materials	<p>All applications must be prepared on the official application form and completed in strict accordance with the detailed instructions to be found on these forms. Applications which do not comply with the instructions given in the application form will not be considered for review.</p> <p>Please send your application as one complete PDF email attachment to foundation@easd.org before 12:00 midday (CET) on the deadline date 15 March 2022.</p>

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Additional information	<p>Review criteria are as follows:</p> <p>Significance: Does the study address an important problem in keeping with the goals and focus areas of this Programme? If the aims of the application are achieved, how will scientific knowledge be advanced? What will be the effect of the proposed studies on the concepts or methods that drive this field?</p> <p>Approach: Are the conceptual framework, design, methods and analyses adequately developed, well integrated, and appropriate to the aims of the project? Are they supported by preliminary data? Does the applicant acknowledge potential problem areas and consider alternative tactics?</p> <p>Innovation: Does the project employ novel concepts, approaches or methods? Are the aims original and innovative? Does the project challenge existing paradigms or develop new methodologies or technologies?</p> <p>Investigator: Is the investigator appropriately trained and well suited to carry out this work? Is the work proposed appropriate to the experience level of the principal investigator and other researchers, if any?</p>

	<p>Environment: Does the scientific environment in which the work will be carried out contribute to the probability of success? Do the proposed studies take advantage of unique features of the scientific environment or employ useful collaborative arrangements? Is there evidence of institutional support?</p> <p>Budget and feasibility: Is the requested budget appropriate for the proposed study? Is the requested duration suitable for completion of the project?</p> <p>Contribution towards a larger research project: Is the work described in the application intended as part of a larger project? If so, is there any overlap? Is there a clear explanation how the new work will contribute towards the overall success of that larger project?</p>
