Descripción general de la ayuda, Candidatos y Propuestas

The European Foundation for the Study of Diabetes (EFSD) was created by the European Association for the Study of Diabetes (EASD) to provide multiple funding initiatives in all areas of diabetes research. The aims of EFSD are to encourage and support research in the field of diabetes, to rapidly diffuse acquired knowledge and to facilitate its application.

EFSD has established this independent research programme called the EFSD/Boehringer Ingelheim European Research Programme in Microvascular Complications of Diabetes to encourage new products aimed at advancing current knowledge in this domain through innovative basic or clinical research.

To achieve the goals and objectives of this Programme, EFSD invites applications be issuing this "Request for Applications" (RFA) which indicates joint funding as well as areas of research emphasis.

This EFSD/Boehringer Ingelheim European Diabetes Research Programme is intended to stimulate and accelerate European basic and clinical research in the specific area of microvascular complications (retinopathy, nephropathy and neuropathy) of diabetes. Proposals dealing with the following are especially but not exclusively welcome: investigations of various cell types in the eye and kidney and their role and interaction during the course of development of diabetic retinopathy and diabetic nephropathy.

Financiación y Duración

Research will be supported through the award of research grants of up to Euro 100,000 in total for basic research projects (payable in full at the start of the project) and up to Euro 300,000 for clinical research projects (with a duration up to 3 years, payable in instalments following approval of annual scientific progress reports). Please note that projects involving clinical trials will not be accepted for this call.

All investigators funded by this Programme are required to submit a scientific progress report at the end of the project period. For those projects where funding is distributed over a period of more than one year, interim progress reports will also be required. Such reports will be subject to assessment prior to the release of any further funds.

Investigators must provide EFSD with copies of papers accepted for publication, and must acknowledge the support of the Programme in all written material by use of the phrase: "supported by an EFSD/Boehringer Ingelheim grant".
