Descripción general de la ayuda, Candidatos y Propuestas

Short-Term Research Fellowships are established to enable young scientists and clinicians in the early-stages of their research career in respiratory medicine to visit a Host Unit in a (European) country other than the candidate's own, with the aim of learning a research technique not available in the Home Unit. The research training should benefit the Home Unit when the applicant returns there, by leading to research developments and activities back onsite.

International

a. Candidates should be scientists, physicians with MD, MSc, PhD, MD-PhD or qualified allied health professional (non-MD) in a filed related to the respiratory field. b. Open to candidates based in Europe. The host unit should be based oversea/outside of Europe. c. Applicants should justify why the research project cannot be completed or attained within a European institute, and why going abroad is essential. d. A return to the home unit is mandatory upon fellowship completion. e. Applicants should hold an active ERS membership.

Conditions:

a. Candidates should be actively engaged in the respiratory field. b. Applicants must be postgraduates holding a university degree in any field related to respiratory medicine (MD, MSc, PhD, MD-PhD). c. Postgraduate scientists such as immunologists, biologists, geneticists, pharmacologists, biophysicists, chemists, etc. involved in respiratory science, are entitled to apply for the ERS Short-Term Fellowships. d. Qualified healthcare professionals (non-MD) working in respiratory health/medicine are entitled to apply for an ERS Short-Term Fellowship. e. Candidates should have adequate fluency in the language spoken at the host institute. f. Applications having been previously rejected may be resubmitted; they should be improved, where possible

Financiación y Duración

ERS short-term fellowships encompass a living stipend, a child allowance and a travel grant. Subsistence rates are indicative and subject to change. The subsistence rates depend on the yearly ERS fellowship budget and the variable inflation, exchange rates and the cost of living in the host country.

ERS Short-Term Research Fellowships' duration is between 1 and 3 months maximum.

Procedimiento para la solicitud

Applications and all supporting documents must be submitted in English and online using the following link http://www.ersnet.org/ers-funding/fellowships/short-term.html.

- a. Information provided by applicants in the **online application** form will be compiled into an abstract by the system, and transmitted to ERS Experts as a synopsis. Fellowship are awarded based on scientific merit, quality of information provided, well-written and well-argued research project description, etc.
- b. Applicants should provide and upload the following documents on the online application platform: i. A short curriculum vitae . ii. A list of publications, sorted out in the following order: 1) original peer-reviewed papers, 2) review articles and 3) any other relevant publication. iii. A research project description including references. iv. The host supervisor's short curriculum vitae. v.
- c. ERS forms should be downloaded online and sent to the home and host supervisors and referee, for completion. The latter complete, sign (mandatory) and return all documents to the applicant in a scanned pdf/jpeg or word format. -Home Supervisor's signed release form + supporting documents. -Host Supervisor's signed acceptance form + supporting documents.
- d. Supporting documents to be uploaded online:

The host supervisor's list of publications.

- Statement on salary status during the ERS fellowship by the host supervisor. - Statement on salary status during the ERS fellowship by the home supervisor. - ID digital photo in high resolution (300 dpi). - Scanned copy of candidate's highest degree (PhD, MD, MSc, etc.). - Scanned copy of applicant's ID card or passport. - For applicants with children under 16 years of age, a scanned copy of child/children's birth certificate(s) or family record book
